

*Philippians Chapter One*  
*Expanded Translation: Verses 13-19*

- 13. With the result that my imprisonment has become plainly understood (because I am) in Christ, and has been circulated throughout the entire Praetorian Guard and to all the rest of Rome.**
- 14. In fact, the majority of the brethren (royal family), since they have received confidence in the Lord because of my imprisonment they have a much greater courage to communicate the Word of God without fear.**
- 15. On the one hand certain ones (legalists & reversionists) are proclaiming Christ; they are doing this because of their jealousy and discord, on the other hand (at the same time) certain ones (advancing believers) are proclaiming Christ because of good motivation.**
- 16. The latter category from the motivation of love, knowing that I am appointed for the verbal defense of the gospel.**
- 17. The former category because of the motivation of deviance and self-promotion, not from pure motives since they presume to arouse (stimulate) mental distress with regard to my incarceration.**
- 18. What is my conclusion? Only that in every way, whether in false motivation or true motivation, Christ is being proclaimed. In fact, in this, I possess inner happiness and I will certainly continue to possess inner happiness.**
- 19. Indeed, I know that this will turn out for my deliverance through your intercessory prayer and logistical provision, motivated by the Spirit of Jesus Christ.**
